L-1 Celebrate the 40th Anniversary of the Tony Award-winning La Cage aux Folles

La Cage was the first Broadway show in history to celebrate the love story between two men in leading roles. Arriving at the Palace Theatre at the dawn of the AIDS epidemic in the early '80s, many on Broadway assumed the show was doomed by the trauma of current events. Instead, it was an joyous and loving hit, playing to sold-out audiences, gay and straight alike, who understood and embraced the singular and shared dream of "I Am What I Am."

He is celebrated for the books for the Tony-winning musicals *Kinky Boots, Newsies, Hairspray,* the landmark *La Cage aux Folles* and, most recently, the acclaimed revival of *Funny Girl.* He is now a *New York Times* bestselling author of *I Was Better Last Night: A Memoir.* Taking a stand as an openly gay playwright, musical librettist and actor, Fierstein pushed gay and lesbian life into the spotlight on Broadway making it a lively, vibrant and thoroughly complex subject for contemporary theater.

An early and now longtime champion of Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS, when the world of Broadway theater shut down during the pandemic, Fierstein took up quilting and hasn't stopped. His one-of-a-kind handmade creations are the treasured belongings of his closest friends, family members and now fans, as today he has quilted one of his coveted masterpieces just for you!

D. The 1984 Tony Award for Best Musical for La Cage aux Folles, and a Treasure Trove of La Cage Memorabilia

Fritz Holt was a renowned, revered and respected producer, director and stage manager, beloved by all with whom he worked. Holt, along with partner Barry Brown, were the executive producers of the original La Cage aux Folles.

On June 3, 1984, the Tony Award for Best Musical was placed in Holt's hands. Three years later, at the age of 46, Holt passed away from the ravages of AIDS. Holt's Tony was left to his sister who, in turn, bequeathed it to Broadway Cares. His beloved companion and business partner, Barry Brown, went on to be a founding board member of Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS in 1988, and still serves as a Trustee today, 35 years later.

This piece of theater history is the centerpiece of the La Cage-themed portion of the Grand Auction and the inspiration for today's 40th anniversary reunion celebration.

A. **Angela Lansbury** Hang a piece of theater history on your wall with this classic portrait of the late Angela Lansbury, taken backstage at her dressing table at Broadway's *Deuce* and signed by the icon herself. For 75 years, Lansbury graced our screens and the Broadway stages before passing away last year at 96. The recipient of six Tony Awards, she garnered acclaim for *Mame* and *Gypsy*, *The King and I* and *Sweeney Todd*, to name but a few. She gained worldwide acclaim for her memorable film roles, including her Oscar-nominated performance in *The Manchurian Candidate*, and her 12-year television run as everyone's favorite small town crime novelist, Jessica Fletcher, on *Murder*, *She Wrote*.

B. **Hal Prince and Stephen Sondheim** This print features the legendary Hal Prince and Stephen Sondheim, and is signed by both men. The esteemed director and the composer/lyricist met in 1949 and set the tone for hundreds of productions to come. Sondheim, an iconic lyricist and musical genius, worked on classic musicals like *Into the Woods, Company* and *Sunday in the Park with George*. He performed alongside the likes of many of the legends featured as ornaments including Andrews, Channing, Close, Lansbury and Verdon. With decades of work and contributions to entertainment through song and dance, Evans, who passed away in 2021, surely left a mark and is a legend in his own right.
